It's a win-win situation: you get a safe parking spot at the church, and the phyouth group raises money. The cost is \$20, and more is always welcome. Also, be sure to buy your snacks from concession stand 29, which will be operated by phyouth.



"The phyouth group raises money to offset the cost of youth doing mission work throughout the year," said Jay Clark, Pastor with Youth & Families. "It is estimated that more than 100 phyouth and adults spent almost \$40,000, with at least half of that going to the Ozark Mission Project. We invite you to give generously."

Hog Parking has been an annual tradition for almost 30 years, even before PHUMC had a parking deck. "When it began, we had three games and would charge \$5 at each game. Then we went to two games a season and increased the price to \$15. When we went to one game a year, we increased the price to \$20," Clark said. "Over the years, we have also had people who couldn't come on game day and instead they send us a check for youth missions — that is always appreciated." 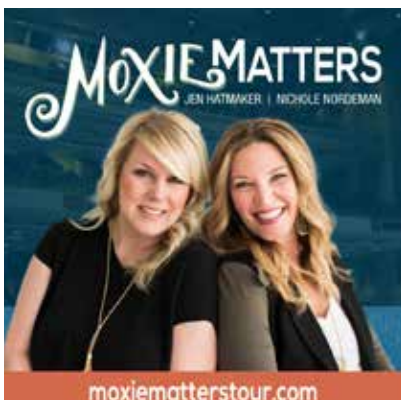
