Purpose: The purpose of this scholarship is to financially assist deserving students who are majoring in music or the arts. The successful recipient will receive a **\$1,000.00** scholarship that may be renewable for three additional years based upon continuing requirements. It will be applied to tuition only and sent directly to the recipient's college or university.

Qualifications: The applicant must be an Arkansas resident and a graduating high school senior or college undergraduate enrolled in a four-year accredited college or university, and majoring in music or the arts. Preference will be given to a student who is also a member of Pulaski Heights United Methodist Church or who has participated in Adventures in the Arts Program at PHUMC.

Requirements: Completed application form must be received no later than **March 6, 2020**. Finalists will be notified by **March 16, 2020**. An audition or interview may be required, and would be scheduled for 10:00am to 12:00pm on **March 20, 2020**. Please return completed form with official high school transcript and two sealed letters of recommendation from an instructor, department head, or major instructor to:
