Use the information below to share the story together and do follow-up activities with your child(ren). As you share the story, also have a Bible available to show the children where it is located.

(April stories are located in ark 11:1-10; John 20:1, 11-18) (This week the focus will be on the Empty Tomb!)

Center yourself for your time together by singing:

You may want to start your time together by centering yourselves with a song. The song for today is called "Praisin"


(It is song to the tune of "Boom, Boom, Ain't It Great To Be Crazy")


You may want to sing the song several times and change "clap," to "stomp," "shake," and "jump."

Read the Bible story together





Follow-Up Activities:

Look at the Bible story card together and help your children find the four butterflies in the boxes on the side. Help find each butterfly in the large picture.

Paper Craft Activities:

- Color the picture of Mary with Jesus. (See the end of the lesson material.)
- Another craft option if you have the items available (Make a Butterfly which reminds us of new life. To do so you will need a coffee filter, watercolor markers, and a pipe cleaner)
- 1. Give your child a coffee filter and some markers. Let them color the filter.
- 2. After they are done coloring, sprinkle the filter with a little bit of water to let the colors run together. Allow to dry.
- 3. Once dry, prepare pipe cleaner by bending in half. Twist the bottom (folded end), 1/3 of the folded pipe cleaner, around itself to form the "body".
- 4. Next, pinch the center of the dry coffee filter together and use the V portion of the pipe cleaner to secure the body and wings together.
- 5. Bend the top 2 ends of the pipe cleaner into the 2 antennae.



If you did not do these activities last week then maybe you can do them this week or repeat them.

Blessing and Prayer Time:


Blessing: Have your child out their hand and trace a cross on the back of their hand as you say the following;
