Dear Preschool Parents,

The PreSchool Sunday School lesson for Sunday, May 3 focuses on the story of Peter and John from Acts 4:1-22. Use the information below to share the story together and do follow up activities with your child(ren). As you share the story, also have a Bible available and show your child(ren) where it is located.

Center yourself for your time together by singing:

Time to Get Together

(Tune: The More We Get Together) It's time to get together, together, together. It's time to get together and listen right now. 'Cause we'll hear a story that's found in the Bible. It's time to get together and listen right now.


Read the Bible story together (Peter & John)



Peter and John

As for us, we can't stop speaking about what we have seen and heard. (Acts 4:20)

Read the Bible Story Together: Follow the Suggested Motions



Acts 4:1-22

It was time to pray at the temple. (Make proying hands.) Peter and John were walking (Walk in place.) to the temple to pray. (Make praying hands.)

At the temple was a man who could not walk. (Shoke head no.) The man asked Peter and John for money. (Hold out hands.)

Peter said, "I do not have money," (Shoke head no.) "but I can give you a better gift. I can give you Jesus Christ." (Hold out hands.)

The man who could not walk (Shake head no.) stood up and walked. (Walk in place.)

He was so happy, he began to leap and jump. (Leap and jump.)

The happy man walked (Wolk in place) into the temple with Peter and John.

This was the first (Hold up one finger) time the man had been able to enter the temple.

The man was so happy to be able to praise (Hold hands up high.) God and pray! (Make praying hands.)

Follow-Up Activities:

Discussion:

Say: With God's help, Peter and John were able to help the man that could not walk? They were continuing to go out and share God's love, serve, and heal those in need, just as Jesus had told them to do. Jesus instructs us to do the same.

Ask: Have you helped someone recently? How did you feel when you were able to help someone? What are some things we could do as a family to help someone?

Paper Craft Activity:

- Peter Heals Puzzle paper craft (See the second to last page for this activity.)
- Help your child(ren) cut apart the picture to create puzzle pieces. Have them glue the pieces back together on a piece of paper to form the picture again. (See the last page for this activity sheet.)

Jumping and Leaping (Game):

Tell your child(ren) that you are going to play a game. They are to do the movement you call out. Call out movements (such as hop, skip, and so forth) on eat a time.

Say: The man was so full of joy to be healed, he didn't just walk to the temple. He may have leaped because he was so happy!

Ask: What movements would you use to express your joy?

Blessing and Prayer Time:

Blessing: Have your child out their hand and trace a cross on the back of their hand as you say the following; (You can also use something like lip balm, soap, lotion, etc. to draw a cross on the back of their hand as you say the following blessing.)

Say: _____ (child's name), God loves you. God blesses you. God is always with you.

Prayer: (It might be something like)

Dear God, help us go out and do what Jesus taught us to do. To share God's love with everyone, just as Peter and John did. Amen.

Faith Family Follow-Up activities to use through the week (Below and on the next page):

Note: For the Serving Time activity – This was written in a pre-social distancing time. (Alternative Suggestion is as follows.)

For the Serving Time activity – During this time you may not be able to deliver supplies to an after-school program. You could always gather them and set them aside for a later time to be delivered.

For the Travel Time (or any time) – Song "Tell of God" (Tune: Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star)

Tell of God to all your friends. Tell them God's love never ends. God is good, and God is great. Clap your hands and celebrate. Tell of God to all your friends. Tell them God's love never ends.


