Dear Preschool Parents,


The PreSchool Sunday School lesson for Sunday, May 10 focuses on the story of Peter in Jail from Acts 12:1-17. (Main points to take away – prayer is important to both us and to others whom we pray for, God hears our prayers, God answers them not in our time but in God's time, and we have to have faith and be reassured that the answers may not always be what we want but rather we what God knows is best for us.) Use the information below to share the story together and do follow up activities with your child(ren). As you share the story, also have a Bible available and show your child(ren) where it is located.

Center yourself for your time together by singing:

Time to Get Together

(Tune: The More We Get Together)
It's time to get together, together, together.
It's time to get together and listen right now.
'Cause we'll hear a story that's found in the Bible.
It's time to get together and listen right now.

Read the Bible story together (Peter in Prison):



Follow-Up Activities:

Discussion:

Say: Peter's friends prayed for him. God heard their prayers and sent an Angel to him to help him escape.

Ask: How do you think Peter felt when the Angel appeared?

How did his friends feel when Peter appeared to them?

Have you ever been surprised to see someone you were not expecting?

Have you ever had someone tell you they were praying for you?

How did that make you feel?

Say: God hears all of our prayers, just as He heard Peter's friends praying for him.

Sometimes the answers to our prayers surprise us, just like Peter's friends were surprised. When we pray, we need to have faith and remember that God always knows what is best for us and for others.

- Prayer Postcard (See the 3rd and 4th to last page for this activity.)

 Print this document as a 2-sided page. Help your child(ren) cut out the 2 postcards for them to decorate and color. Mail the postcard to someone they said a prayer to God for. (See the last page for this activity sheet.)
- Gift for Mom (See the second to last page for this activity) Sunday, May 10th, is Mother's Day. Make a gift to give to Mom to let her know how much you love her. Options: Color the picture. If you have the extra supplies (tissue paper, glue or paint) have your children add an extra element to the flowers (See the end of the lesson material.)











The Angel Said - The Leader (Game):

Remind your child(ren) that the Angel in our Bible story told Peter to follow. Let's play a game of follow the leader. I will say "The Angel said, _____ (call out an action). If I say "The Angel said" then do what I told you to do. If I don't first say "The Angel said" then do not move.

Let your child(ren) also get a turn at being the leader.

Blessing and Prayer Time:

Blessing: Have your child hold out their hand and trace a heart on the back of their hand as you say the following; (You can also use something like lip balm, soap, lotion, etc. to draw a heart on the back of their hand as you say the following blessing.)

Say: _____ (child's name), God loves you. God blesses you. God is always with you. And, God always hears your prayers.

Prayer: (It might be something like)

Dear God, thank you for always being with us and for listening to our prayers. Help us remember that you will answer our prayers with what is best for us. Amen.



In South Africa, the John Wesley Community Centre serves vulnerable children who have been affected by HIV/AIDS. As of 2018, South Africa had the largest HIV epidemic in the world. The John Wesley Community Centre supports children who have lost their parents to HIV/AIDS, as well as children who have the virus. Here are some services that children can find at the Centre:

- An after-school program that provides homework help and fun activities
- · A spelling team
- A chess club
- Marimba and recorder classes
- Gymnastics classes
- · A computer center and library
- A preschool for kids ages 1–6
- HIV/AIDS awareness training for adults and children
- Community support groups
- Counseling

Through the John Wesley Community Centre, children and others are given emotional and educational support. The John Wesley Community Centre strives to create an environment which promotes change through active and real participation.

This organization serves the local community. Many women come to the John Wesley Community Centre to engage in self-directed projects making items they can sell. There are also teams who
