This Infant/Toddler Sunday School curriculum for Sunday, June 14, and for the month of June, will focus on Believers Share. Use the information below to share the story together and do follow-up activities with your child(ren). As you share the story, also have a Bible available to show the children where it is located.

(June's Bible Story is in Acts 4:32-37)

(May's Bible Verse is Acts 4:32: The community of believers was one in heart and mind. None of them would say, "This is mine!" about any of their possessions but held everything in common.)

Center yourself for your time together by singing:

You may want to start your time together by centering yourselves with a song. The song for this month is called "Christians Shared"

(It is song to the tune of "Hot Cross Buns")

Christians Shared



Reproduce the "Kindness Award" from the Award/ Message Patterns on p. 171. Keep awards on hand and give them to children from time to time as you see them acting in kind ways.

People who believe in Jesus are asked top share everything we have with others. We should keep practicing how to share.







Movement Activity:

Recite this rhyme and encourage your child(ren) to repeat your motions.
Say: I want to show God that I love God so. (Put your hands on your heart.)
I even want other people to know. (Point away from yourself.)
So, I will be helpful. I will be nice. (Point to yourself.)
I might even hug my family twice. (Make a funny face.)
I have some toys I know I can share. (Nod your head.)
I can show others that I care. (Put your hands on your heart.)
God will be happy when I try to do this. (Point to the smile on your face.)
It's like giving God a hug and a kiss. (Hug yourself, then blow a kiss.)

Snack Activity:

Make a fun snack mix as a family to share. Everyone will get one small cup of an item. Each person will take a turn pouring their item into a bowl so it can be shared, and all the different items can be mixed to create a fun yummy snack mix.

- Or you could use different fruits and make a fruit salad.




