## September 13, 2020

### Month of September – Creation

**Bible Verse:** The Lord God made all. (Genesis 2:9)

### Bible Story:

Share the story from the picture below, or share a more simplified version below that.



### Simplified Story:

Share the story from the activity coloring sheet at the end of this lesson.

### Questions:

1. Who made the world?
2. What did God say when He created each thing?

## **Spiritual Practice:**

Find a spot outside or take a walk in God's creation. Have your child look for different colors. When they say a color, pause and say "thank you, God for all things that are \_\_\_\_\_ (*color they mentioned*)."

End by saying, thank you for all the living things that You created for us to enjoy!

## **Craft Activity:**

Copy the sheet below. Help your child connect the lines to see some of the things God made. Encourage them to name some of the things God put in His world.

## **Creative Exploration:**

Google for webcams at various zoos across the country. Watch the wonderful animals that God created and talk about them. Ask your child(ren) what their favorite one is.

## **Blessing:**

Bless your child by touching them and saying "\_\_\_\_\_ (child's name) "God made you, God blesses you and cares for you. Go now in love."

## **Prayer:**

Dear God, thank you for making a beautiful world that we can see all around us. Amen.
