

PHUMC Sunday School lessons for Preschool – 5th grade.

November 22, 2020 – Jacob's Ladder (Genesis 28:10-22)

Prepare to Wonder

Faith Word: Blessing

As Jacob was leaving his home and traveling to Haran, he grew very tired. He lay his head down next to a stone and after falling asleep, he had a very vivid dream. He dreamed that there was a large staircase that started on the ground and reached into the sky. God appeared in Jacob's dream and promised to be with Jacob and to bless him and all of his descendants.

Jacob believed that the stone was in a special and holy space, and knew he would never forget this dream. Jacob was also scared by the dream. He was not expecting to be in the presence of God while snoozing on a rock. God made God's presence known to Jacob.

God sometimes shows up in our own lives in very unexpected ways. We might not have a vivid dream of angels and staircases. However, there might be times when we least expect it that God leads us and shows us a new way. This can happen through prayer, meditation, a walk outside, or even a conversation. There is no limit to where God might show up.

Moments with children can also be a reminder to us of God's presence. A child's laughter, words, or even play can serve as a way for us to recognize God's promise to continue working in the world. I we will pay attention, we can find God everywhere!

Spiritual Practice for Adults

Take time this week to be still and to just listen for God. Find a quiet place, away from distractions. Find a comfortable position for your body to relax. Close your eyes and put your hand over your heart. Feel the love of God beating in your heart as you quiet your mind and listen for God. You are inviting God to visit by sitting in silence. It is important to give space to God to speak in our hectic lives.

WONDER together

Do you think sleeping upon a stone would be comfortable? Have you ever had an interesting dream?

CONTINUE to Wonder

When have you noticed a blessing in your life? How are you a blessing for God?

READ the Bible Story



Preschool Activity Alter Rock (Art)

Supplies: Rock, Paint, Paintbrush, supplies to cover the table

Prepare Ahead: Search outside for a rock big enough for your child to paint. Clean the rock off before they begin.

Say: Jacob used a rock to lay his head on when he rested. After God came to Jacob in his dream, Jacob knew he was in a holy place. Jacob built an alter of stones to God in that place.

You can make your own alter to help you remember that God is always with you and to help you remember to listen for God.

- Have your child paint their rock.
- Let it dry and then place the painted rock in your child's room so that it can serve as a special alter where when seen they can be reminded that God is with them and they can always come to him. Remind them that God will listen to them and God wants them to listen to Him as well.



Early Elementary Activity Stone Story (Interactive)

Supplies: rocks or stones, permanent markers

Go outside and find a medium or large sized rock or stone. Paint or decorate your rock by drawing something that represents a different part of today's Bible story.

Wonder: What does God want us to know from hearing this story?





Older Elementary Activity Wherever You Go (Discussion)

Supplies: None

Today we learned about how God went with and protected Jacob on a journey. Our Bible verse reminds us of that. "I am with you now, I will protect you everywhere you go." Genesis 28:15

- Where are some places you feel God with you?
- Let's pray to feel God's presence with us wherever we are.

Pray: God, thank you for your protection. We pray to feel the comfort of your protection wherever you go. Amen
