November 29, 2020 – Peaceable Kingdom (Isaiah 11:6-9)

Prepare to Wonder

Faith Word: Blessing

This week we begin our celebration of Advent as we explore the segment of Scripture known as the Peaceable Kingdom. This part of scripture is about what the world will be like when everyone and everything can live in peace under the rule of the new king. In this vision, children are safe, and enemies can live side by side without hurting or destroying each other. In this world, wolves will live with lambs, leopards and goats will lie down together, cows and bears will eat together, lions will eat straw like oxen, children will play safely over snake's holes, and nothing will be harmed or destroyed. In this kingdom everyone will now God.

The writer invites us to step outside of our world and imagine what could be. The imagined world is what is possible only when the new king comes. This text reminds us of the blessings that could be when the Messiah comes. These verses often are read as we prepare to remember the birth of Jesus during Advent.

This week, we'll explore our own visions of what peace looks like and ways we can contribute to making peace in our own world. We will continue our exploration of the spiritual practice of blessing through prayer and do some activities to help us remember the Bible story. We'll also begin our celebration of Advent.

Spiritual Practice for Adults

Who do you know who is different from yourself? What makes that person different? Do you struggle having a relationship with this person? Why?

Today's scripture invites us to a world of peace. This does not mean we must agree with everyone, but it does ask us to strive for peace. Can you be a person of peace, despite differences?

This week take time to write down three statements that you and others can agree on and three points on which you do not agree. Pray about these statements and ask God for ways you can find peace in the midst of disagreement.

WONDER together

What might it be like to lie down with a wild animal? How can you be peaceful?

CONTINUE to Wonder How can you be a blessing for the whole world?

Wonder with Me

READ the Bible Story

Isaiah 11:6-9 (Read from your Bible or see below for the Celebrate Wonder version)

Roll the Wonder Cube. Take time to answer a few of the questions.

*To make the Wonder Cube that will be used for 13 weeks, print off the Cube template (see below), cut out, and fold on the dotted lines. Tape or glue the flaps together to create a cube.

Blessing: Bless your child by touching them and saying "_____ (child's name), You are a child of God. You are filled with peace."

Prayer: Thank you, God, for Jesus and for peace in our hearts. Amen.

When there is peace, a wolf can live with a lamb.


When there is peace, a leopard can lie down with a goat.


When there is peace, a cow and a lion can share their food without fighting.

When there is peace, a child will lead us.








Celebration Chart

Preschool Activity Advent Wreath (Art)

Supplies: Printed coloring page.

Say: Today is the first Sunday of Advent. Advent means "arrival". It is a time when we are getting ready for the arrival of a very special baby named Jesus!

It can be hard to wait for Christmas and baby Jesus birth to get here. God knows it is hard but God wants us to know how special this gift is and He wants us to get our hearts ready to be able to enjoy this very special gift. So, during Advent, we often spend time preparing our hearts by reading God's words for us in the Bible and we often have special prayers we may pray or things we may do.

Today I want you to start to work on an Advent wreath. You will only color part of your art today. Each Sunday in advent you will color a little bit more! When we get to Christmas you will complete your artwork and you will finally be able to celebrate the wonderful gift of Baby Jesus!

- Print color page
- Help your child find the numbers on the page and show them the Key where it tells them what color to color the different areas on the page
- This Sunday (11/29) they will color the wreath and 1 purple candle and the flame on that candle.
- Next Sunday (12/6) They will color a second purple candle and flame.
- The following Sunday (12/13) they will color the pink candle and flame.
- The fourth Sunday (12/20) they will color the last purple candle and flame.
- On Christmas (12/25) they will color the flame on the center candle. The candle will remain white! It reminds us of Jesus!

Older Elementary Activity Family Peace Prayer (Writing)


Supplies: None

Wonder: What would you pray to God if you were praying for world peace?

Say: Let's work together to write a family peace prayer. Each person can write down ideas. Share ideas and together combine for a family peace prayer. Pray your family peace prayer together. Put where you can pray this prayer together again.



This is what an Advent wreath looks like. Use the color-by-number guide to color this picture.



First Sunday of Advent (11/29) – Color the wreath green, 1 purple candle and the flame on that candle.

Second Sunday of Advent (12/6) – Color a second purple candle and the flame on that candle.

Third Sunday of Advent (12/13) – Color the pink candle and the flame on that candle.

Fourth Sunday of Advent (12/20) – Color the last purple candle and the flame on that candle.

Christmas Day (12/25) – Color the flame on the center candle. This candle will remain white. It reminds us Jesus!
