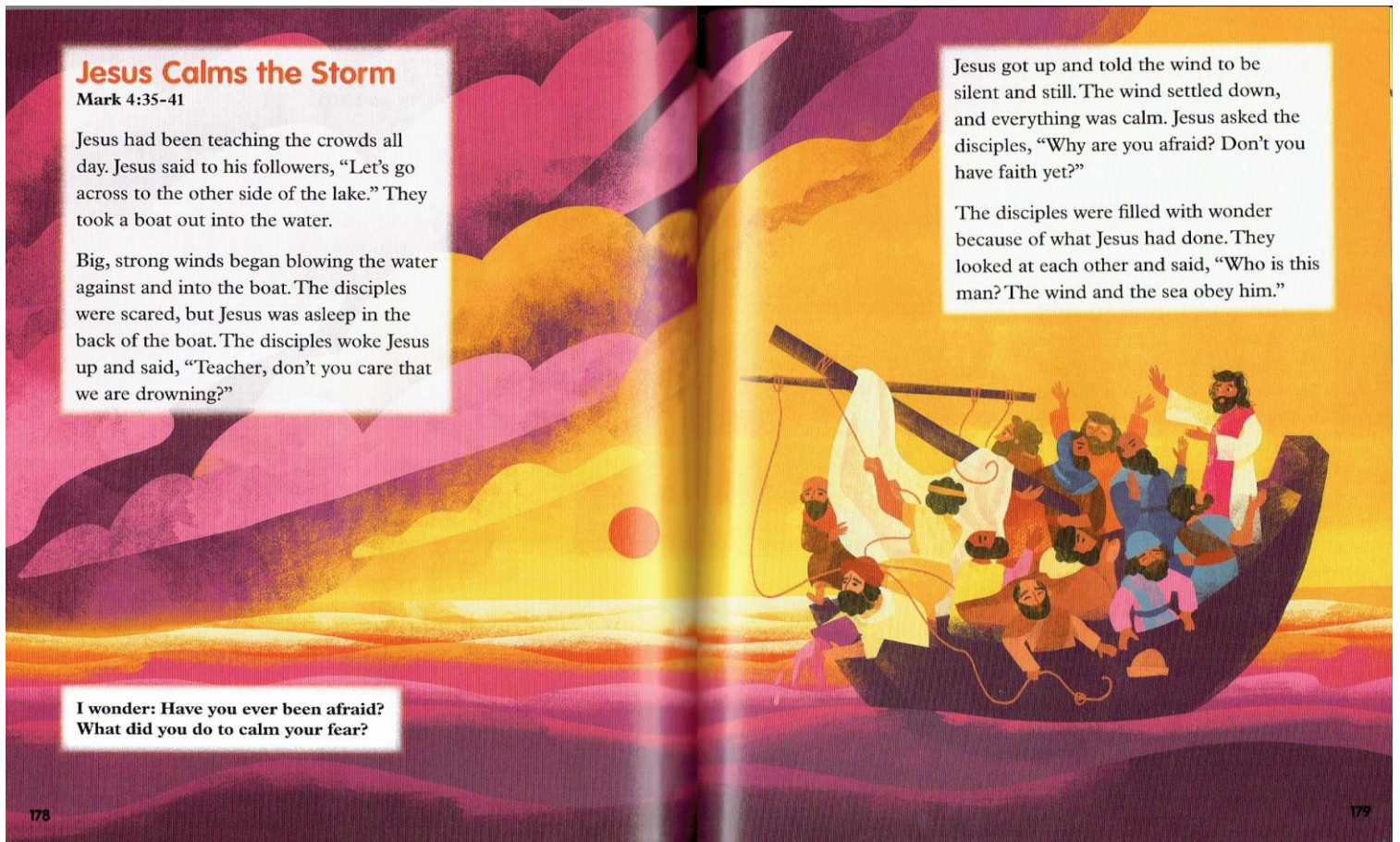
## February 14, 2021

**Dear God, help us remember that you are with us always. Strengthen our faith and help us not be afraid. Amen.**

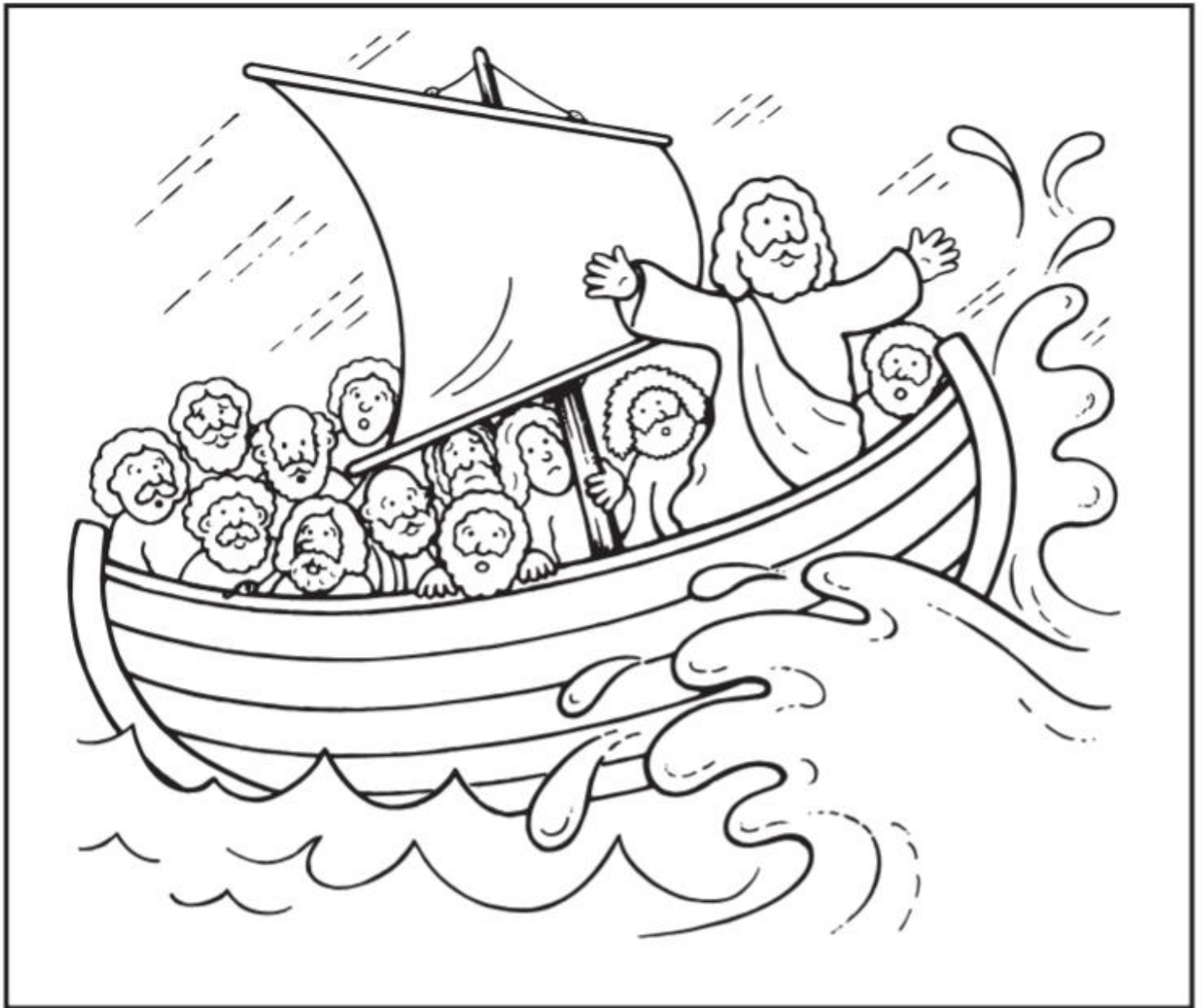

## Jesus Calms the Storm – Mark 4:35-41

### Wonderful Waves (Snack)

**Supplies:** graham crackers, frosting or whipped cream topping, bowl, blue food coloring, plastic knives, plate

**Directions:** Set out graham crackers, plastic knives, and a bowl of frosting (or whipped cream). Let your child(ren) drop a few drops of blue food coloring into the frosting (whipped cream) and take turns stirring until the frosting is tinted blue. Have your child(ren) spread frosting “waves” on the graham crackers. Remind them that in our Bible story today we heard that Jesus and his friends were caught in a storm that had big, scary waves. All of Jesus’ friends were scared. But, Jesus taught them to not be afraid because he reminded them that God is always with them.
