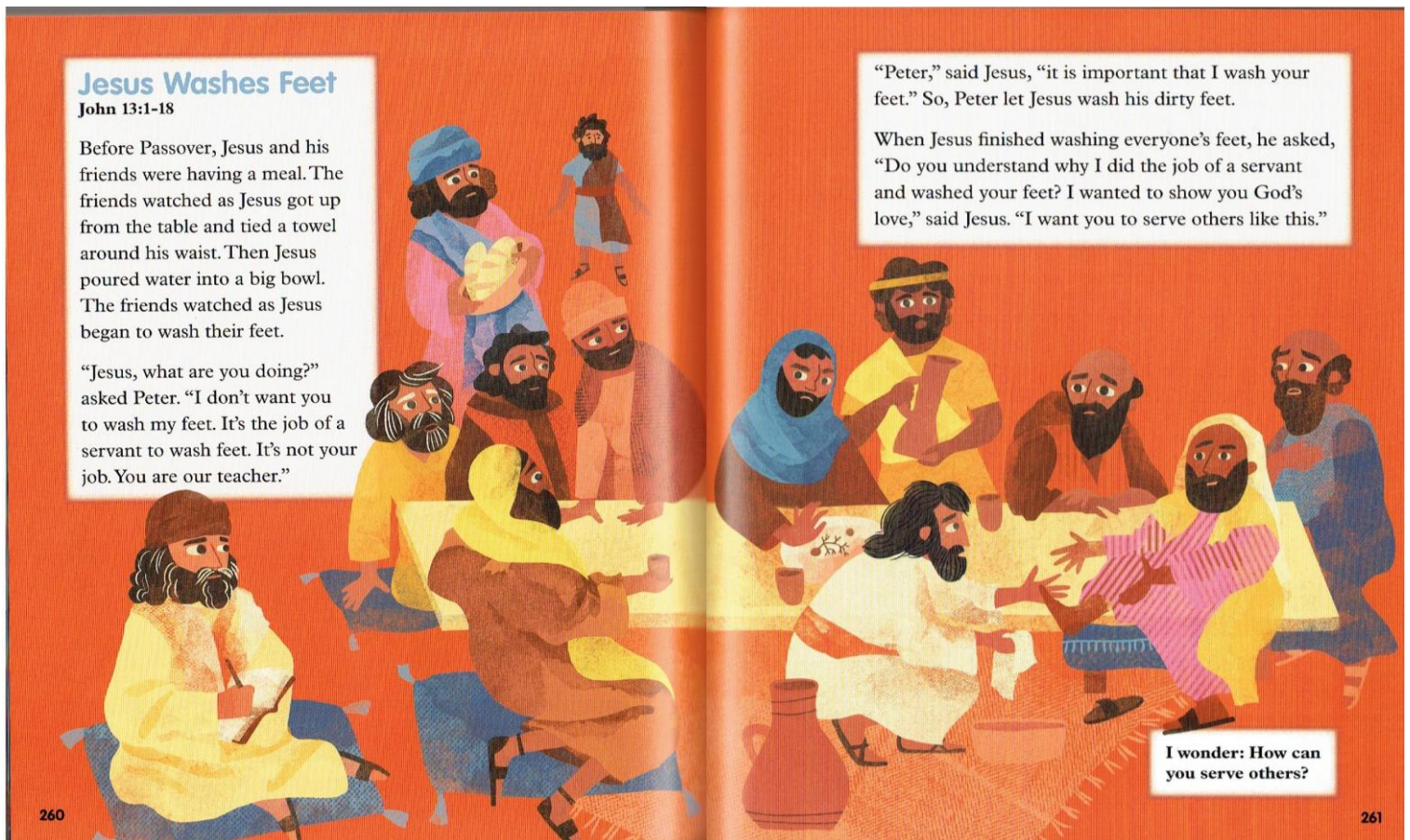

Jesus Washes Feet

John 13:1-18

Before Passover, Jesus and his friends were having a meal. The friends watched as Jesus got up from the table and tied a towel around his waist. Then Jesus poured water into a big bowl. The friends watched as Jesus began to wash their feet.

“Jesus, what are you doing?” asked Peter. “I don’t want you to wash my feet. It’s the job of a servant to wash feet. It’s not your job. You are our teacher.”

“Peter,” said Jesus, “it is important that I wash your feet.” So, Peter let Jesus wash his dirty feet.

When Jesus finished washing everyone’s feet, he asked, “Do you understand why I did the job of a servant and washed your feet? I wanted to show you God’s love,” said Jesus. “I want you to serve others like this.”

I wonder: How can you serve others?

Question:

1. What did Jesus do for his friends? (Washed their feet)
2. Why did he wash their feet? (To show them God’s love.)
3. Does Jesus want us to do things for others so that we can show God love to them? (Yes)
4. What can you do for others? (Be kind, love them, help them, share with others, etc.)

Activity: Washing Hands and follow-up coloring sheet

Supplies: printed copy of the following coloring sheet and some color crayons.

Wash your child's hands and every time you do, remind them that God loves them and wants them to love others too.

Have them color the picture below.

Blessing:

Touch your child and say: **"God loves you; you are a blessing."**

Prayer:

Dear God, show us how to serve others every day. Amen.

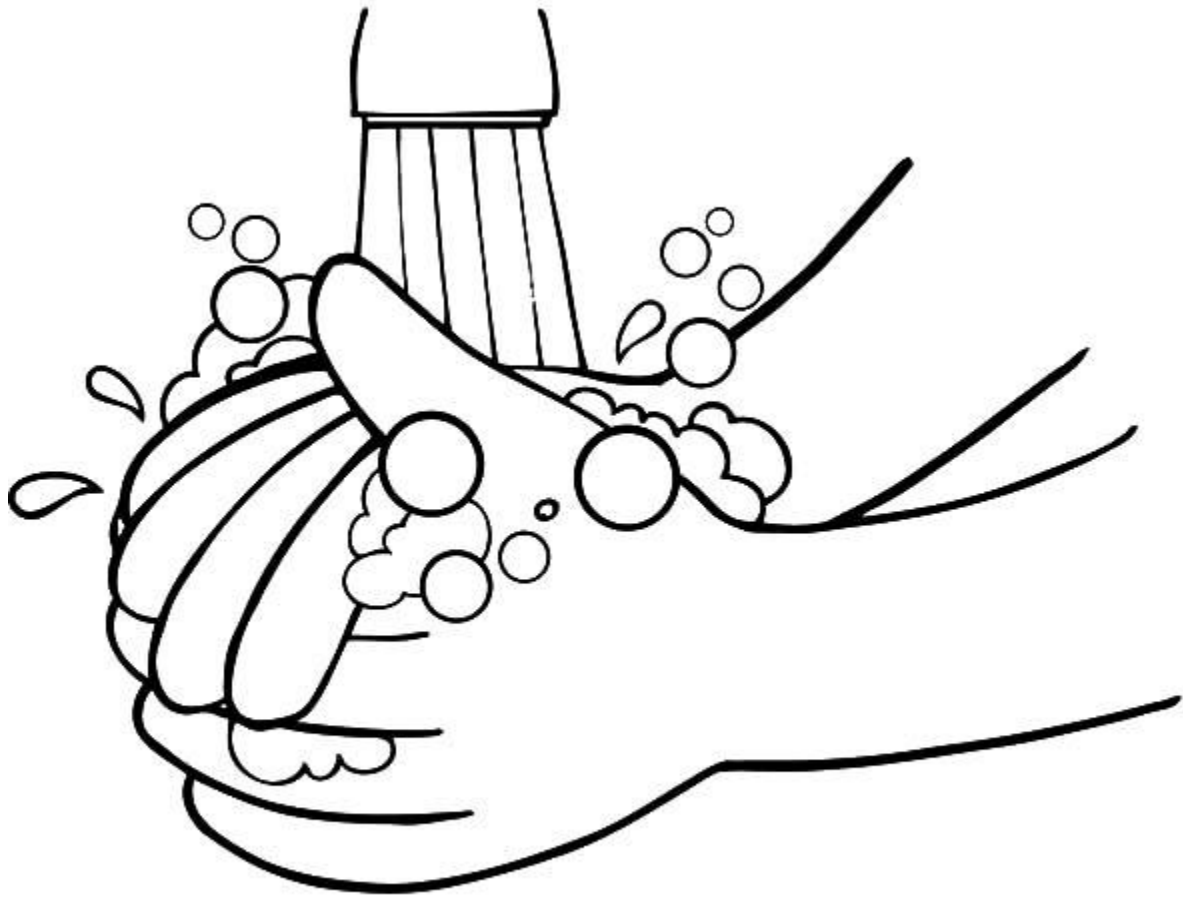
