

PHUMC Sunday School lessons for Preschool – 5th grade.

March 21, 2021 – Praying in the Garden (Luke 22:39-46)

Prepare to Wonder

Faith Word: Remember

After Jesus and his friends, the disciples, shared the Passover meal, Jesus went to a garden on the Mount of Olives, called Gethsemane, to pray. Jesus often went alone to pray and may have gone to a place in the garden he had been before. This time, he took a few of his friends with him and asked them to stay awake. Jesus then went a little ways away to pray.

Jesus knew his death was coming soon. He didn't want to die, and he was probably sad and anxious. He prayed that God would present him with a solution so he wouldn't have to die, but he also knew it was up to God. After fervently praying, Jesus was visited by an angel. The angel set his mind at peace, and Jesus knew what he had to do.

When he returned, he was upset to see his friends asleep. Luke says they were asleep because they were overcome by grief. It is possible they were also exhausted and were not concerned because they did not know what was going to happen to Jesus.

When talking with young children, focus on Jesus praying at a time of sadness and uncertainty for him. Jesus showed by example that we can pray to God when we are scared or frightened. Prayer brought Jesus comfort, even though he did not receive the answer he was looking for. Children can learn that prayer can happen anytime we are feeling lost or afraid. God will listen.

Wonder with Me

READ the Bible Story

• The Last Supper, from Luke 22:39-46 (Read from your Bible, see the verses listed below, or see one of the following pages for a picture of the Celebrate Wonder version.)

³⁹ Jesus went out as usual to the Mount of Olives, and his disciples followed him. ⁴⁰ On reaching the place, he said to them, "Pray that you will not fall into temptation." ⁴¹ He withdrew about a stone's throw beyond them, knelt down and prayed, ⁴² "Father, if you are willing, take this cup from me; yet not my will, but yours be done." ⁴³ An angel from heaven appeared to him and strengthened him. ⁴⁴ And being in anguish, he prayed more earnestly, and his sweat was like drops of blood falling to the ground.¹²

⁴⁵ When he rose from prayer and went back to the disciples, he found them asleep, exhausted from sorrow. ⁴⁶ "Why are you sleeping?" he asked them. "Get up and pray so that you will not fall into temptation."

SHARE the Faith Word

Go in Peace


Blessing: Touch your child and say: "God loves you; you are a blessing."

Prayer: Dear God, thank you for the love Jesus gives us. Amen.


Additional Activity for each age group

Preschool Activity Ways to Pray (Movement)

Supplies: None

Have your child stand with you and repeat the words and motions after you.

Say the following:

- We want to pray every day. (Place hands together in prayer.)
- You can pray many ways. (Hold hands out wide.)
- Kneel. (Go to your knees.)
- Touch your hands. (Fold hands together.)
- Bow your head. (Lower your head.)
- Stand up straight. (Stand up, keeping knees and shoulders back.)
- Reach up high. (Hold hands open above your head.)
- Hold your neighbor's hand. (Hold hands with the person next to you.)
- Look your neighbor in the eye. (Focus on the friend you are holding hands with.)

What is your favorite prayer position? Do you pray any other ways?

If you choose, sing the following song together to the tune of "Jesus Loves Me".
