April 25, 2021 – Believers Share (Acts 4:32-37)

Prepare to Wonder

Faith Word: Share

Today's Bible story is from the Book of Acts, also known as the Acts of the Apostles. The Book of Acts describes the life of the early believers. The believers met together often. They shared everything they had. They would sell their possessions and give the money to whomever needed it. They ate together in one another's homes, and they shared their food happily and freely. Many people liked them, and the number of believers grew.

We know the early believers had problems within the church. We hear about those later in Acts and the rest of the New Testament. But in the beginning, the believers came together as a community to support one another. They emphasized teaching, fellowship, sharing goods, and prayer. The result as that no one was in need.

As Christians today, we are called to share what we have with those in need. Sharing can be hard for children. It can also be hard for adults. We might not have the resources to share, or feel as if we haven't shared enough. We might not want to share things we have worked hard to obtain. The way the early believers shared everything seems impossible today. However, we can find ways to share with others today. Even young children can discover the joy of sharing with others.

Young children can begin to understand that caring and sharing for all people, even in the smallest way, is possible. There are so many people who do not have basic human needs. Whatever we have to share will be needed by someone. A simple card of love can mean so much to someone who is lonely. Help your children discover what they can share.

³² All the believers were one in heart and mind. No one claimed that any of their possessions was their own, but they shared everything they had. ³³ With great power the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God's grace was so powerfully at work in them all ³⁴ that there were no needy persons among them. For from time to time those who owned land or houses sold them, brought the money from the sales ³⁵ and put it at the apostles' feet, and it was distributed to anyone who had need.

³⁶ Joseph, a Levite from Cyprus, whom the apostles called Barnabas (which means "son of encouragement"), ³⁷ sold a field he owned and brought the money and put it at the apostles' feet.

SHARE the Faith Word

Select the material toward the end of the lesson that is age appropriate for your child(ren)





Preschool Activity Fruit Salad (Snack)

Supplies: a different fruit for each family member (*cut the fruit up, keep each different fruit separate and put each type in their own individual bowl*), larger mixing bowl, spoon, plates and forks or spoon and napkin

• Give each person a plate, a fork or spoon, and a napkin

Say: The believers of Jesus shared all they had, even their food. We could keep the bowl of fruit we each have or we can share the fruit with all of us by putting it all in this big bowl.

Ask: What do you think the believers of Jesus would have done?

Wonder: Why do you think we should share our fruit with others?

Fun extra activity – see if your child can identify the different fruits in this picture. Did you all use some of these fruits in your snack?
