### Dear Congregation,

In service to our mission statement, Love God, Love Neighbor, Change the World, we are moving forward in all areas of ministry. As a result, we are excited to announce that we will begin children and youth Sunday School starting on Sunday, October 3rd! Childcare will be provided for worship and Sunday school (9 am – Noon). Everyone working with children and youth will be required to have been vaccinated.

In addition, as of Sunday September 12th, we will no longer have worship attendance restrictions. It has limited our capacity to open our doors to all who choose to worship here. Quite frankly, our worship attendance numbers in all services have been well below our maximum allowed to maintain a safe and healthy environment. We will still have appropriate measures to maintain a safe worship experience. We will continue to wear masks while in our facilities. # **OCTOBER FOOD PANTRY CHALLENGE!**

**The October Food Pantry Challenge** starts Sunday, October 3 and runs through Sunday, October 24. The challenge encourages families to read Scripture, pray at mealtime and collect food together for four weeks in October. Choose the same day each week for activities together or a day that works best for your family.

### Week 1: Challenge foods: Green beans or corn - Bible verse: Matthew 25:35

Mealtime Prayer: Loving God, we pray for cooperation and support for life saving assistance to people struggling from food insecurity and hunger in our community and around the world. Send life-giving rains at just the right time, create good conditions for families to grow food for their survival, and cease conflict so your children will no longer go to bed hungry each night. Amen.

### Week 2: Challenge foods: Cornbread or stuffing - Bible verse: John 6:35

Mealtime Prayer: Almighty God, it is difficult to see children suffer, especially from hunger. We pray for you to give children across the world daily bread today and help our schools stay open despite COVID outbreaks. We pray for those children who count on schools every day to receive needed meals through school meal programs as well as instruction that helps them grow and learn each day. Thank you for our schools, teachers and administrators and for the children they serve. Please keep our Arkansas children safe, healthy and strong. Amen.

### Week 3: Challenge foods: Cranberry sauce or pumpkin - Bible verse: Luke 6:21

Mealtime Prayer: Lord, thank you for allowing our church to serve so many families through our food bank. Thank you for the team that runs the food bank and every family who will donate food this month. Please draw near to our church as we serve you in new ways and away from group gatherings and our normal routines. Give us strength to find you and feel your Spirit with us every day. Bless our donations and every home they touch. In Christ's name. Amen.

Week 4: Challenge foods: Sweet potatoes or mashed potatoes - Bible verse: Psalm 146:6-7




#### Linda Iones, Co-Facilitator

Family Promise of Pulaski County is a wonderful organization helping temporarily homeless families stay together. It is part of the national organization that combats family homelessness. Since 2005 PHUMC has assisted FPPC by providing shelter and meals for these families here at the church 4 weeks each year. The last time we hosted was in January 2020 - before Covid-19.

Things have changed with churches no longer able to provide shelter. Instead FPPC is now renting 3 apartments in North Little Rock where 3 families stay until they find jobs and save enough money to be able to get out on their own again. Churches are still providing their breakfast/lunch food and evening meals. PHUMC is doing this for the weeks beginning on these Sundays: September 26, December 26, March 27, 2022 and June 26, 2022.

Do you want to be more involved in mission work? Here's your chance! We need a new PHUMC Family Promise coordinator! Our wonderful church member Gwen Efird did an amazing job in that position for many, many years. She passed the torch to me about a year before the pandemic hit and I have served as interim coordinator ever since.
