


SERVICE SPOTLIGHT -ALLEN BIRD



A LETTER FROM SYLVIA BORCHERT, CHAIR OF BOARD OF STEWARDS

In 2023, the Board of Stewards members were asked at each meeting to discuss, in small groups, the topic of Generosity. We discussed "what does generosity look like in church?, how do we model generosity?, how can we teach generosity to our congregations?, and what message would you want to provide to our congregation about generosity. The following is the culmination of their work.

Generosity means remembering our local needs and giving of our TIME (being present and volunteering for missions). Generosity comes in all shapes and sizes and nothing is too small to reflect a generous heart. It is an ongoing practice. We are to be bountiful in our giving of money, time, kindness, sharing of our talents and fulfilling a need. We are to give without expectation of reward. Generosity in service reflects that our time is our currency - make "yes" your default answer for helping.

We recognize there are barriers to overcome in order to become generous people. Some of these are an unawareness of volunteer opportunities, especially those that are small opportunities that may occur only rarely, need only a few people, or do not require a large expenditure of resources. Another barrier is that many other things compete for our time and resources which means we need to make church/mission a top priority. A generous church needs to be a "mission-driven" church. Finally, we need to release the idea of "what do I get out of it?" and ask "what and how can I contribute?"

Actions to foster generosity include:

- Every churchgoer should feel charged to find a place to volunteer.
- Better explain opportunities for generosity in all media newsletter, emails, and social media.
- Sunday School classes can adopt a project.
- Promote a contest for fulfillment of volunteer hours, for example, youth v. adults.
- Determine what percent of our membership volunteers, and how to grow that number.
- Provide videos of volunteer experiences.
- Set goals that are churchwide. For example, how many people give and how much do we want to raise, how many volunteer hours are logged and how many hours are needed?
- Provide visual aids to educate members to inspire generosity. Use videos
 or other media to educate congregations about opportunities recognizing
 different personality types van drivers, greeters, Sunday school teachers,
 Altar Guild, Stephen Ministries, youth counselors, child-care volunteers,
 etc. Find ways to determine where people's talents lie and then how to
 match them up if they want to help but don't know where they are best
 suited.


