- A Capital Campaign in the fall of 2025 to address a variety of facility needs including major leaks, heat and air, lighting, exterior brick issues, as well as children and youth areas, and much more. There is a great sense of urgency about addressing these matters. No remodeling of existing spaces will be done as a part of this campaign.
- Build a strong and vibrant Men's ministry program for all ages. Monthly gatherings, as well as recreational opportunities, and small groups will be emphasized.
- Exploring ministries for people with special needs of all sorts. This is a much-needed ministry that we must begin to focus on.
- More small groups for all ages. These will include both spiritual and social activities. In addition, we will offer the Bible in 90 Days reading program from June 2-August 25 as a summer spiritual small group opportunity.
- Strengthening an already robust missions program. In addition to all we
 are presently doing, we are bringing back the care bags and expand that
 ministry even more.

As you surely know, we have so many opportunities already in place to volunteer in assisting us with pastoral care needs, mission projects, senior adult ministries, children and youth events, as well as much more. These ministries listed above provide a small taste of all you can be a part of in 2025. I look forward to a wonderful year of ministry in the name of Christ with each of you!

PHUMC Caring Ministries By the Numbers

At PHUMC, caring for one another is at the heart of our ministry. Through PHUMC's Caring Ministries, we extend compassion and support to individuals in need, embodying Christ's love in tangible ways. Whether offering prayers, providing transportation, or simply being present in moments of joy or sorrow, these ministries touch the lives of countless people within and beyond our church family. Below are just a few of the many ways Caring Ministries fulfills its mission of care and connection.

• Shawl and Blanket Ministries – This group of 23 knitters and sewers have distributed 30 shawls and blankets for people experiencing hospitalization and always have extras on hand. Since the start of these ministries we estimate that over 1,400 shawls or blankets have been given out.

• Hospital Callers – Four volunteers call the major hospitals in the Little Rock area daily to find out if any patients have a connection to PHUMC so that direct visits from clergy and staff can be set up.
Caring Cards – By the end of 2024 a group of nine volunteers will have sent approximately 530 cards to persons who have experienced illness, are in

recovery, or who are in need of a caring note.

• Grief Committee – Five volunteers send cards to those who have experienced the loss of a family member. In 2024 over **115 families** were contacted.

 Helping Hands – Every week, 28 volunteers gather at the church to provide respite for caregivers by sharing of their time with persons in various stages of memory loss.

• Home Hospitalization follow-up – A volunteer calls people in our church family who have been released from the hospital to see if any additional care is needed.

• Stephen Ministry – Over the past 29 years, 165 persons have been trained to provide one-on-one care to people experiencing difficulties in their lives, such as hospitalization, discouragement, coping with terminal illnesses, moving or relocating or dealing with life or spiritual crises. Currently there is a **leadership team of three**, and **30 active Stephen Ministers**.


• Intercessory Prayer Group – 14 people have, within this year, prayed for over 425 individuals. Prayers are lifted for persons in the hospital or discharged, experiencing a death of a family member or friend, as well as raise praise and thanks for recent births, marriages, and new members to PHUMC. Anyone who submits a prayer request to the church will have that request met. • Caring Wheels – A team of **10 drivers** have made **25 transportation** trips to assist persons who need to visit a doctor.

• Christmas Gifts and Cards – Two volunteers send gifts and cards to people in retirement or nursing facilities during the Christmas season.

• Sunday Van Drivers – Eight van drivers are available on a rotating basis to pick up persons from their homes and transport them to church and back home each week.

• Visitation to Retirement and Nursing Care Facilities – An amazing group of 12 volunteers call on 12 different retirement and nursing facilities to visit directly with members or congregants of PHUMC regularly.

Our "**Real Talk: Sex and Sexuality**" workshop will be 4:30-7:30PM on Thursday, January 16, in Wesley Hall. This workshop is designed for 10th-12th graders as a follow up to basic reproductive and puberty education taught in 5th grade. This fully comprehensive and affirming sex ed course is designed to help older high schoolers reframe sex and sexuality in safe, healthy, positive, and responsible ways as they enter their early adulthood.
