

Update From the Preservation Oversight Committee

We're pleased to share this update on some initial projects included in our recent Capital Campaign. We thank all those who have given generously to This Place Matters and what it will mean for our church campus in the years ahead.

- Boiler Replacement** – A new boiler has been purchased and installed in the closet in Room C236 (formerly the Mirror Room).
- Chairs** – Proposals in process to purchase 250 Chairs for Wesley Hall and 500 Padded Chairs for Argue Hall (gym).
- Children's Outdoor Playground** – New flooring has been selected and awaiting final cost proposals.
- Choir Room Improvements** – Cost proposals for paint, new carpet, acoustical panels on walls and new lights currently being developed.
- Fire Panels** – Final proposals have been received, contract awarded, and materials and parts ordered.
- Interior and Exterior LED lighting** – Specifications concluded and awaiting proposals.
- Organ Work** – Final pricing received and agreed upon.
- Tables** – We have purchased, received and are using thirty 5' round tables and thirty 8' regular tables.


