

President William M. Tsutsui is the president and professor of history at Hendrix College. He previously served as dean of Dedman College and Humanities and Sciences at Southern Methodist University from 2010 to 2014. He holds degrees from Harvard, Oxford, and Princeton universities.

An award-winning classroom teacher, Tsutsui is the author or editor of eight books. He has received

Fulbright, ACLS, and Marshall fellowships, and was awarded the John Whitney Hall Prize of the Association for Asian Studies in 2000 and the William Rockhill Nelson Prize for Non-Fiction in 2005. His teaching and research focus on the business, environmental, and cultural history of twentieth-century Japan.
