### **New Creations**

Almost 2,000 years ago, a man named Paul wrote a letter to a house church he started a few years earlier in Corinth. He urged them to let the old self fall away and become a new creation in Christ. (2 Corinthians 5:17) I wonder what this means for us, individually and collectively, as a church today. We are called to let go of some of our past, our personality, our bad habits, and become a new creation by embracing the love of Christ and living in that love. The love of God should fill us and overflow so that others can see it. None of us are always successful at this, but we have our moments. I had the pleasure of seeing one of those moments this last week: seeing kids come to the St. Luke Learning Center and being a part of the celebration to open the learning center. It is a wonderful testament to what the love of God can call us to do and the ways we can collectively impact our neighborhood.

The Learning Center also shows a significant step forward in the transformation of the church. I am well aware that the church, collectively, is going to look dramatically different at the end of my life than it did at the beginning. A lot of people have written about the transformations and how fewer people are interested in Church and faith. The church is shifting and struggling with how to respond. I believe the response is to embrace the call from Paul, individually and collectively, to become a new creation in Christ. The call to let go of some of our old problems and habits, and become a new creation collectively as the body of Christ.

The transformation will not be easy. It requires all of us to let go of things and to continue to embrace a love of God that calls us to think more about our neighbor. It challenges us to look into the community and see how we can make the world a better place. I know that the St. Luke Learning Center is one of those transformational acts. It is the love of God being shown to neighbors and kids in the community. I







want to thank everyone who has been a part of it, and I want to encourage you to continue to let the love of God transform you, to continue to become a new creation and help the church embrace its identity and become a new creation as well.
