New Pridecorps Adult Class This Month

Pridecorps: LGBT Youth Center has called PHUMC home since its first meeting in January 2015. Its mission is to celebrate, support, & empower LGBT youth, ages 13-20. Since that first meeting teens from 18 central Arkansas counties have been gathering twice monthly for fun & fellowship. Pridecorps provides a safe place for kids, who are too often isolated, to meet others, develop friendships, & engage in affirming activities. Facilitated primarily by young social workers, meetings include games, yoga, meditation,

educational programs, nearby outings, & of course, pizza. Off site activities have included private Arts Center workshops, behind-the-scenes zoo tours, bowling, geocaching, & much more.

Pridecorps Prime, a support group for LGBT adults, will launch later this month at PHUMC. Subject to the wishes of the participants, the group will tentatively meet twice monthly. Meetings will include educational programs, cultural outings, & recreational activities.
