New Additions to Pet Ministry Coming October 27th!



When I first served as an associate pastor at Pulaski Heights in 1992, I'm pretty sure I led the first Animal Blessing service we ever had. It was held on the lot where we now have a parking deck. We had bales of hay, an offering basket, a PA system, music and singing, prayers, and individual blessings for a lot of God's creatures. Over the years, I've blessed dogs, cats, lizards, snakes, and even a hen with an eye infection. Praise the Lord, she got well!

As a life-long dog lover, I know how much my pets have meant to me, how they have brought me comfort, laughter, and security. That's why, when the opportunity to allow dogs and handlers to serve together in the ministry of therapy dogs, I jumped at it. I have seen elderly folks, children, sick and distressed people positively impacted by therapy dogs.

That was two churches ago, and I am proud to say, Pulaski Heights has embraced this outreach. We've trained over 70 dogs and handlers to serve, and Sunday, October 27th, we will recognize those who give their time to this ministry.

However, not only will we celebrate therapy dogs, we will also introduce a fuller Pet Ministry to include: pet prayer requests, end of life pet support, educational classes for pet owners, community service projects for animal rescue organizations, and pet loss or grief support. We want to recognize that, for many of us these days, our pets are also family, and they are certainly part of the good creation of a loving God. Bishop Ken Hicks, who loved dogs, used to say, "'God' is "dog" spelled backwards. :)


