Oh, they were all together in one place. (Hold up 1 finger)




When the wind began a-blowing (Wave hands in air like the wind.)

# **Movement Activity:**

• Make a Ribbon Dancer stick — If you have not already done so, make a Ribbon Dancer stick and have a dance party. To make the Ribbon Dancer stick take 3 strips of red ribbon (each about 2-feet long) stacked together and then taped to a craft stick. Play children's Christian music and have a dance party. God's Holy Spirit is with us and helps us move like the wind! \*Play children's music or sing the Happy Birthday to my church song (words below) as you dance and twirl with your ribbon.

# **Game Activities:**

- **Find the Flames:** Print out the flame card sheet found at the end of the lesson. Cut the cards apart and hide the cards around the house for your child(ren) to find. Remind your child(ren) that on Pentecost, there was the sound of wind and flames of fire. This surprised the friends of Jesus. The Holy Spirit had arrived, letting them know that God was with them all.
- Play "I Spy" something red. Encourage your child(ren) to look around and find all things that are red. The Red reminds us of Pentecost & the flames of fire that appeared above the heads of Jesus' friends to let them know God was with them and they were not alone.


#### **Bubble Play and Bubble Prayers:**

- <u>Bubble Play</u> Blow bubbles with your children and invite them to make the sound of the wind as you do. Say: On Pentecost, the Holy Spirit came like wind and fire. God is always with us through the Holy Spirit.
- <u>Bubble Prayers</u> Try this as a family. Get a bottle of bubbles and gather your family outside.
  Explain that you are going to pray with bubbles. You each will take a turn by saying a prayer out loud and then blow bubbles to the sky. You can help your child see their bubbles (prayers) floating up to God.

Say: \_\_\_\_\_, the Holy Spirit is always with you.


Prayer: (It might be something like)
