

## Lost and Found

**Grab your Bibles and please turn to Luke 15:1-10.**

**As we read our Bible let's look at scripture on 3 levels-our heads (details of the verse), our hearts (prayerfully considering what the verse says to us and how we can apply it to our life) and our hands (how we can take the verse and examples of how we can become the hands and feet of Jesus on earth!).**

**Read the scripture.**

**Questions to answer (using our heads!!!!).....1) How many sheep? 2) How many sheep were lost? 3) How did the Shepherd respond to the lost sheep? 4) What does the Shepherd do when he finds the one lost sheep?**

**5) How many coins did the woman have? 6) How many coins did the woman lose? 7) What did the woman do when she realized she had lost one coin? 8) What did the woman do when she found her lost coin?**

**Questions to answer (using our hearts!!!!).....1) What can you take from this scripture and apply to your life? 2) What lessons do you see from these verses?**

**Fun questions to answer (using our hands!!!!).....How can these Bible verses go from your heart to your hands? Share some examples of being the hands and feet of Jesus from these verses.**

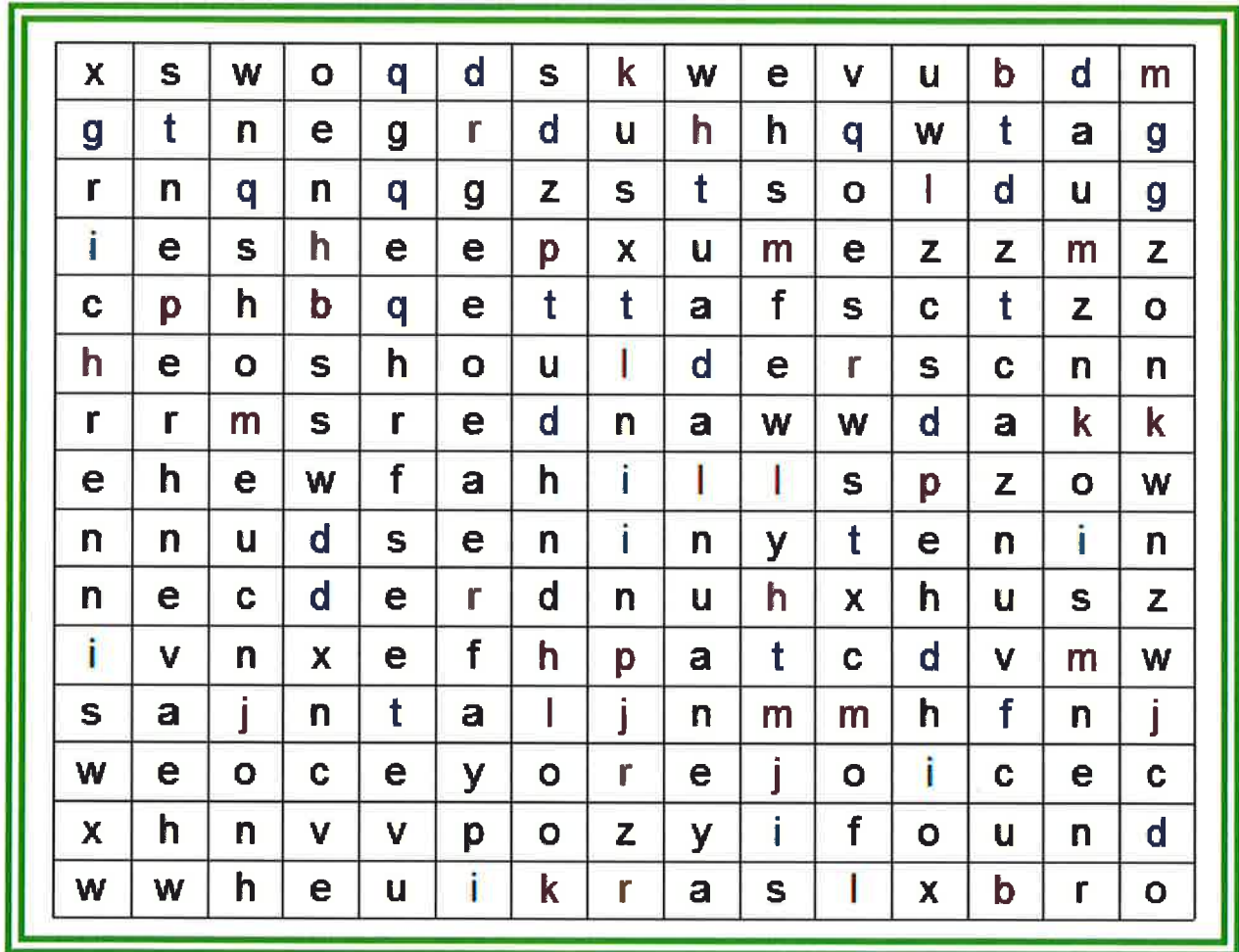
