Pulaski Heights United Methodist Church Preschool Sunday School Material for August 23, 2020

Dear Preschool Parents,

The Preschool Sunday School lesson for Sunday, August 23 focuses on Paul and Silas being in jail but still singing and praising God because they knew that God was with them. Scripture reference is: Acts 16:16-40 (Main point to take away – We can sing and praise God even when we are sad, mad, or scared. Question – What song do you like to sing to praise God?)

Use the information below to share the story together and do follow up activities with your child(ren). As you share the story, also have a Bible available and show your child(ren) where it is located.

Center yourself for your time together by singing:

Time to Get Together

(Tune: The More We Get Together)
It's time to get together, together, together.
It's time to get together and listen right now.

'Cause we'll hear a story that's found in the Bible.

Read the Bible story together (Singing for God):



Singing for God

Shout triumphantly to the Lord, all the earth! (Psalm 100:1)

Read the Bible Story Together: Follow the Suggested Motions



Based on Acts 16:16-40

Today we will hear a story about a man named Paul. (Cup hand around ear.)

Paul had a friend named Silas who traveled with Paul. (Walk fingers.)

They told many people that God loves them all. (Hug yourself.)

One day Paul and Silas found themselves in jail, but they didn't mind at all. (Shake head no.)

Paul and Silas trusted God, and they began to sing. (Sing, "Praise God; praise God.")

An earthquake came and set them free. (Jump up and down.)

The jailer was afraid the prisoners would escape. (Shake and act afraid.)

Paul and Silas shared Jesus with their friend and did not leave. (Shake head no.)

"Come home with me," said the jailer, "and share with my family." (Motion to come.)

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Follow-Up Activities:

Discussion:

Say: Paul and Silas traveled around and spread the word about God's love and what Jesus taught them to everyone. The Roman government did not like people sharing their faith in God with others. So they put Paul and Silas in jail. Paul and Silas could have been mad and they may have been scared.

Ask: But, no matter how they felt, they knew that God was with them and so how did they thank God for being there with them?

Ask: How do you thank God for always being with you? Do you sing praises to Him? What do you like to sing when you do?

Finger Plays & Action Rhymes:

Paul & Silas Bible Story Rhyme (Active Story Rhyme Option)

Paul and Silas were locked up tight, (Hold wrists together as if shackled)

Even though they did things right. (Give the "O.K." sign)

They shared Jesus with the guards, (Point to lips)

Accepting Jesus isn't hard. (Point to your heart)

Paper Craft Activities:

- Paul and Silas in Prison Print off the paper craft activity (second to last page), cut along the red
 lines and fold the door along the dotted blue line. Get an additional sheet of paper and glue
 the frame of the door to the paper and then glue Paul and Silas behind the door on the paper
 too.
- **Temple Coloring sheet** (See the last page for this color sheet.) Print off the coloring sheet. Have your child(ren) find the other prisoners in the pictures. They listened and saw how much Paul and Silas loved God.

Blessing and Prayer Time:

Blessing: Have your child hold out their hand and trace a heart on the back of their hand as you say the following; (You can also use something like lip balm, soap, lotion, etc. to draw a heart on the back of their hand as you say the following blessing.)

Say: (child's name), **God loves you. God remembers you. God is always with you.**

Prayer: (It might be something like)

Dear God, I love to list Your name in songs and praise. Help me share my faith with others as I do. Amen




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Paul and Silas in Prison

Punch out the three figures below: Paul and Silas and the prison door. Then carefully further separate the prison door at the top, bottom, and right, folding the door open along the blue dotted line. Glue Paul and Silas close together on a piece of construction paper. Glue the prison door (frame only!) "over" the two men. When the door is opened, you should be able to see Paul and Silas.
