It's time to get together and listen right now.


Read the Bible story together (Singing for God):

Five Little Fingers Prayer Poem (Finger Play Option)

Five little fingers God gave to me (Wiggle fingers.)

The first one says, "Praise God! Yippee!" (Hold up one finger.)

The second one says, "I'm sorry for my wrongs." (Hold up two fingers.)

The third one says, "Thanks, God, for all You've done." (Hold up three fingers.)

The fourth one says, "Help me, God, please!" (Hold up four fingers.)

The fifth one says, "Help my friends and family." (Hold up five fingers.)

Five little fingers help me to pray (Put hands together to pray.)

To God, who loves me very much! Hooray! (Cheer!)

Paper Craft Activities:

- **Jesus Loves Me Coloring sheet** (See second to last page for this color sheet.) Print off the coloring sheet. Have your child(ren) color the picture. Remind them that they can sing, pray and praise God wherever they are every single day.
- Deep Blue Coloring sheet (See the last page for this color sheet.) Print off the coloring sheet.
 Have your child(ren) color the picture. *Today is the last day with our friends from Deep Blue.

Blessing and Prayer Time:
