Dear Infant/Toddler Parents,

This Infant/Toddler Sunday School curriculum for Sunday, August 9, and for the month of August, will focus on The Forgiving Father. Use the information below to share the story together and do follow-up activities with your child(ren). As you share the story, also have a Bible available to show the children where it is located.

#### Center yourself for your time together by singing:

You may want to start your time together by centering yourselves with a song. The song for this month is called "Can You Listen?"

(It is song to the tune of "Are You Sleeping?")

# **The Forgiving Father**

#### **Sharing Faith With Your Child**

Read this Bible story to your child.

**SAY:** Jesus told a story: A father had two sons—an older son and a younger son. The younger son wanted some of his father's money. The father gave it to him, even though it made him sad.

The younger son went far away. He spent the money on things he didn't need and had to get a job feeding pigs. He was so hungry that he wanted to eat what he was feeding the pigs.

The younger son remembered how kind his father was. The younger son wanted to go home and tell his father he was sorry.

When the father saw his younger son walking up to the house, he ran out to hug him. The father was happy his younger son had come home, so he threw a big party for him.

The older son had been working when the younger son came home. The older son was mad and wouldn't go to the party.

The father went outside to beg his older son to come to the party. The older son said he was sad because he had stayed with his father and had done everything his father wanted, but he never got a party.

The father said, "Son, everything I have is yours. But we have to celebrate because our whole family is back together."

Turn this card over and invite your child to count the pigs.


**ASK:** How do you think the father felt when everyone was back together to celebrate?

#### **Follow-Up Activities:**

#### **Paper Craft Activities:**

• Paper Chain Family coloring sheet (see last page). Encourage your child to decorate the three figures to be the father, the older son, and the younger son. Cut out after decorated.

Say: In our Bible story there is a family with a father, an older son, and a younger son.

Ask: Who is in our family?

Say: We also are part of God's family. Everyone belongs in God's family. God love us

all so much!

#### Song:

Jesus Taught (Song Option)

(Tune: "London Bridge")

Jesus taught about God's love. Turn around; shout "Hooray!" Jesus taught about God's love.

We love Jesus.

#### **Movement Activity:**

Celebrate Dancing (you will need some music)

Say: The father in our Bible Story threw a party to celebrate his younger son coming home. We can celebrate too! Let's dance to music while we celebrate being part of God's family.

#### Game Idea:

#### Who's Missing?

Say: The father saw that his older son was missing from the party, so he went outside to find him. The farmer invited his older son to come inside to celebrate that their family was all together again.

Say: We're going to play a game to find who is missing from our family.

Have the children close their eyes. Choose one person to go and hide.

Encourage those that remained in the room to open their eyes, figure out who is missing (hiding), and go and find them.
