Pulaski Heights United Methodist Church Preschool Sunday School Material for August 9, 2020

Dear Preschool Parents,

The Preschool Sunday School lesson for Sunday, August 9 focuses on King David and the Israelites bringing the Ark of the Covenant to Jerusalem. The Covenant reminded them that God was with them and they celebrated and worshiped God joyfully. (Scripture reference is: 2 Samuel 6:1-19(*Main point to take away – Worship gives us opportunities to praise God and you can praise God in countless ways! Question – How do you praise God? How do you show joy for God?*)

Use the information below to share the story together and do follow up activities with your child(ren). As you share the story, also have a Bible available and show your child(ren) where it is located.

Center yourself for your time together by singing:

Time to Get Together

(Tune: The More We Get Together) It's time to get together, together, together. It's time to get together and listen right now. 'Cause we'll hear a story that's found in the Bible. It's time to get together and listen right now.

Read the Bible story together (Communities Grow):



Dancing for God Shout triumphantly to the LORD, all the earth! (Psalm 100:1)

Read the Bible Story Together: Follow the Suggested Motions





It was a happy day! King David was bringing the special chest to Jerusalem. The special chest reminded David and the people that God was with them. (Say, "Dance, King David, dance.")

King David was so happy to bring the special chest of God home. He planned a big parade so everyone could see the special chest. (Say, "Dance, King David, dance.")

The leader of the parade was King David. He was so happy, he led the parade! All the people rejoiced with music and songs. (Say, "Dance, King David, dance.")

King David loved God so much and was so happy, he praised God with his whole body and danced. (Say, "Dance, King David, dance.")

When the special chest arrived at its home, the parade stopped. King David said a prayer to bless all the people. (Say, "Dance, King David, dance.")

Then King David gave bread, and date and raisin cakes to the people. (Say, "Dance, King David, dance.")

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Follow-Up Activities:

Discussion:

Say: The ark of the covenant was special because it held the stone tablets that God gave Moses on Mt. Sinai. Those tables are called the Ten Commandments. King David celebrated and praised God by dancing as the ark of the covenant was brought into Jerusalem.

Ask: Do you have something special, like the ark of the covenant, that helps you remember God?

Ask: How do you worship and celebrate God?

Paper Craft Activities:

- **Dancing David** Print off the paper craft activity (second to last page). Color the Dancing David. Cut out the finger puppet after it has been colored and help your child put their fingers through the 2 holes for the legs. Have them make David dance!
- **Hidden Pictures Coloring sheet** (See the last page for this color sheet.) Print off the coloring sheet. See if your child(ren) can find the Dancing David. Help them find the other objects hidden in the picture. Have them color the picture.

Dance Party:

Say: David danced with his whole body. We can dance with our whole bodies too.

- Do the Hokey Pokey together. Be sure to do the "put your whole self in" part.
- Ask: What did it feel like to "put your whole self in?" Did if feel like dancing with all your might?"

Blessing and Prayer Time:

Blessing: Have your child hold out their hand and trace a heart on the back of their hand as you say the following; (You can also use something like lip balm, soap, lotion, etc. to draw a heart on the back of their hand as you say the following blessing.)

Say: _____ (child's name), God loves to hear and see you praise Him.

Prayer: (It might be something like)

Dear God, help us praise you with all our strength. Amen

Be Together: Read "Dancing for God" on the other side of this sheet and do the suggested motions together.

Pray Together: What is one thing you want to give praise for today?
