#### August 15, 2021 – Book of Esther (Book of Esther)

#### **Prepare to Wonder**

**Faith Word: Courage** 

Exploring courage through discipline is our spiritual practice for this unit. In previous stories, we have heard about the courage of Rahab, Ruth, and Naomi: three women who faced fear and danger with courage. Through planning and discipline, they saved themselves from danger. IN today's story, Queen Esther not only saved herself but also saved the Jewish people.

Queen Esthere as Jewish, but her husband, the king, did not know she was Jewish. The kings' helper, Haman, didn't like Jewish people, so he tricked the king into making a law that would have all the Jewish people killed. Queen Esther was raised by her cousin Mordecai who also wored for the king. Mordecai convinced Queen Esther that she must intervene wit the king to save her people.

Queeen Estehre took several courageous steps. First, she presented herself to the king without being summoned. Not evern the queen could do that! Second, she invited the king and Haman to a banquet. She made a plan to tell the king she was Jewish at the banquet. When she told the king that she and her people would be killed under Haman's law, the king ws very upset. So, he made a new law that kept Queen Esther and her people safe.

Not only did Queen Esther show courage but she did so with a deliberate plan. She asked her people to fast and pray to give her courage. That courage gave the queen the discipline to carry out the plan. Sometimes we ask for help from others or through the discipline of prayer to be courageous.

#### **SHARE the Faith Word**

Faith Word: Courage – means choosing to act in faith, even when you are afraid.

- 3. Have you ever been afraid to do something? What did you do so you would't be afraid?

• Share the Celebrate Wonder Family Activity Book together (page 24 & 25). On page 25 (and below) you will find the suggested Spiritual Practice activity for the week.

#### Esther


#### **Book of Esther**

Esther lived with her older cousin, Mordecai. Esther and Mordecai were Jews. They loved God and followed God's rules.


The king decided he wanted a new queen. The king chose Esther! She went to live at the palace, but she didn't tell anyone that she and Mordecai were Jews.

#### Jeweled Crown and Bracelet (Art)

**Supplies:** Printed preschool activity sheet below (or trace the crown and bracelet outline on some cardstock or construction paper), color crayons, and/or items to glue onto the crown and bracelet, hole punch, tape, and a rubber band.

Have your child decorage the crown and bracelet as they wish. Take a rubberband and cut it so that it has 2 ends. Tie each end to the holes that you punch on each end of the crown. This will help the crown fit better.

Once the bracelet is decorated, tape the ends together.

Say: Sometimes we need some help to be brave. The help may come from our family, people we love, or praying to God.

Sometimes we just need a symbol, like a crown or a bracelet to help us remember that God can help us be brave.

Wonder: What helped Queen Esther be brave? What helps you be brave?




If you wish, revisit the song for this month – Be Strong (It is to the tune of "The Bear Went Over the Mountain")

Say: The Bible story this week told us that Ruth and Naomi showed courage and cared for each other. Their hearts were strong in the Lord.

Doing Spiritual practices help us connect with God and help make our hearts strong in the Lord too. Let's spend some time with God by singing the song together that we learned last week.




Make an Esther word cloud by filling in the horizontal and vertical lines on the crown with words that describe Esther.




# Esther the Queen Maze
