LENT is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday. The word lent comes from the Anglo-Saxon word lencten which means "to lengthen." It marks a time when the days begin to lengthen noticeably. The season of Lent is a season of preparation for the celebration of Easter. It calls to mind the biblical images of Jesus' forty days in the wilderness prior to the beginning of his public ministry; the Israelites' forty years of wandering in the wilderness before entering the promised land; and the forty days and nights of rain that set Noah and his family afloat on the ark.







