The Tower Bell Peal at the end of the service is silenced during the 40 days and Sundays of Lent. The bells will return for the beginning and end of worship, Easter Sunday, April 17.

LENT is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday. The word *lent* comes from the Anglo-Saxon word *lencten* which means "to lengthen." It marks a time when the days begin to lengthen noticeably. The season of Lent is a season of preparation for the celebration of Easter. It calls to mind the biblical images of Jesus' forty days in the wilderness prior to the beginning of his public ministry; the Israelites' forty years of wandering in the wilderness before entering the promised land; and the forty days and nights of rain that set Noah and his family afloat on the ark.





