


On Friday, the soldiers nailed Jesus to a cross, where He died. Several things happened right then.



Jesus' Final Week






On Thursday, Jesus had a last meal with His disciples. What happened there?




Later that evening, Jesus went to the garden called Gethsemane to pray. Soldiers came. What happened?




Jesus was taken and led away with 2 other criminals to be crucified.





Jesus entered Jerusalem riding a donkey. People threw their cloaks on the road for Him.


