Dear Congregation:

We are overjoyed to announce the addition of **Dr. Frode Gundersen** to our staff as Director of Music and the Arts at PHUMC! Dr. Gundersen is currently Director of Music & Worship at Central United Methodist Church in Fayetteville, Arkansas. Before moving to Northwest Arkansas in 2015, Dr. Gundersen served in full-time Music Director positions at Marvin United Methodist Church in Tyler, Texas; Bartlett United Methodist Church in Memphis, Tennessee; and Highland Park United Methodist Church in Dallas, Texas. Born in Copenhagen, Denmark, he received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Piano Performance from North Dakota State; two Master of Music degrees in Choral Conducting and Sacred Music from Southern Methodist University in Dallas, Texas; and a Doctor of Sacred Music degree from the Graduate Theological Foundation in Mishawaka, Indiana. Dr. Gundersen's choirs have given concerts internationally, which has included singing for the International Church



Music Festivals in Bern, Switzerland and Coventry, England, and for High Mass at the Vatican's St. Peter's Basilica in Rome, Italy. As a pianist, Dr. Gundersen has performed solo recitals and has collaborated with other professional artists for decades. In August 2019, Frode's solo piano album was released, entitled "From the Heart: Sacred Songs & Melodies." One of Dr. Gundersen's current collaborations is with renowned Metropolitan Opera baritone, Keith Harris. Together they perform concerts across the country and have released an album, "Keep on Climbing." Another collaboration is as one half of Orgiano Duo, a professional organ/piano duo, along with concert organist Scott Montgomery.


Dr. Gundersen will begin this new chapter at PHUMC on July 11.






