And so, in remembrance of these your mighty acts in Jesus Christ,

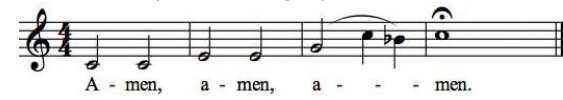
We offer ourselves in praise and thanksgiving as a holy and living sacrifice,
