

The mission of Arkansas Cancer Coalition (ACC) is "to facilitate and provide partnerships to reduce the human suffering and economic burden from cancer for the citizens of Arkansas." ACC hosts the state's annual comprehensive cancer conference, the Arkansas Cancer Summit and the annual Arkansas Cancer Race Challenge. ACC is the only organization in the state focused on organizing partners to help eliminate cancer. This is accomplished through evidence-based programs such as The Arkansas Cancer Plan (ACP), ACP grants, ACC direct programs, and training opportunities.
