Dear Members of PHUMC,

I have some exciting news to share with you! As part of our most recent Board of Stewards meeting, a called Charge Conference was held to discuss moving forward with exterior renovations and targeted interior remodeling of the Chapel and Parlor areas. In accordance with the United Methodist Book of Discipline, the Charge Conference is the first of multiple meetings. In this initial meeting of the Charge Conference, a Building Committee was put in place, and the blessing to move forward to gather more information was received. Now, we will work toward solidifying costs and designs to bring to you. The next formal meeting will be a Church Conference where all PHUMC members have voice and vote before moving forward or not moving forward with actual plans.

The exterior renovation piece is absolutely necessary. Power washing, tuckpointing, and sealing of the Sanctuary, Discipleship Center/Wesley Hall, Norma Story Building, and the Argue Great Hall will have to be done regardless of moving forward with interior remodeling. It will be an expensive, but necessary, endeavor and will help preserve our church for years to come.

The interior remodeling we are proposing offers exciting and creative new opportunities. The chapel renovation would keep that space sacred but with movable seating and altar space with a kneeling rail. It would also emphasize the existing beautiful wood features with new lighting, extend the windows that would overlook the Columbarium and provide natural light, and will be equip it with the ability to simulcast worship services for overflow crowds for funerals and special events. These changes will allow us to make better use of this beautiful sacred space.

A parlor in any home or church is considered a sitting room. In the remodel, this would remain the essential function, but it would be designed to extend into the current hall that connects the main building with the skybridge to the Discipleship Center. This will enable a common meeting place for people to gather and build community, especially on Sunday mornings, creating a halfway meeting point between both of our main worship spaces. Comfortable, intimate seating spaces with access to coffee and water would be the main draw to this space redesigned to make connections with others or simply be. After the presentation in August, one thing the Building Committee will be talking about is how to represent in the interior design who we are as a historic midtown church with over 100 years of history AND update these areas to be more functional in the 21st century. Should the parlor renovation be included in the final plans, we would want to make a clear path from Entrance 1 on Woodlawn to the new parlor area.

The images the Charge Conference saw are not the final product, but an initial design and starting point that will change and morph over the next year. However, I have included a couple of slides that highlight the areas being discussed. The basic timeline is to have a Church Conference in the fall of 2024 to solidify what you, as members of PHUMC, would like to do. If approved, we would move forward with a capital campaign in early 2025 and then begin the remodel as voted on. We will get you more information as it becomes available. I hope you will be in prayer about the scope of this project and how God will continue to use our beautiful campus and the ministries of Pulaski Heights UMC to Inspire Love, Embrace Christ, and Engage the World.




